Dear Beloved Community,

Blessed. Grateful. Willing. So blessed with God's abundance, we are grateful for the gifts of this congregation: authentic and engaged community; relevant and Spirit-filled worship; meaningful service in Cape Cod and our world. Our gratitude calls for a response, and we are willing to answer God's call with a resounding "yes!" Generosity is an important part of each person's faithful response to our loving God. What we do with our time, our talents, and our treasure matters to God. The personal financial decisions we make help us grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ.

Cotuit Federated Church's income comes primarily from the freewill giving of our supportive families. Not everyone realizes that it takes about \$1,500 per year (or \$29 per week) from each of our church families to support the ministry and mission of our congregation. Because of the generous support of church members, the ministry and mission of the church are truly growing:

- We have increased our outreach to those in need both within the church and beyond, doubling the number of meals we dish up at Miracle Kitchen, sponsoring Overnights of Hospitality, and serving through Habitat for Humanity in Joplin and Mashpee;
- Our ministry to children and youth continues to grow, and our confirmands inspire us;
- Our caring ministries are expanding as 50 people commit to be a part of Called to Care, which joins our already powerful Stephen Ministry program;
- Our doors are open wide to our local community through events such as CraftFest and Christmas in Cotuit, as well as providing a gathering space for chair yoga, Boy Scouts, and people in recovery through AA;
- We have seen an encouraging excitement for Bible Study and small groups, with more than 40 people engaged in our book study on Sabbath during the summer and
- We have been able to attend to the necessary upkeep of our church building.

To allow our ministry and mission to continue to grow, we would like to be able to count on your support in the year ahead.

Faithful stewardship invites us to honor God with all that we have and all that we are. Giving is an act of Christian discipleship and is our response to God's generosity. If you're considering a first-time pledge for 2013, one guideline you might consider is to give \$1 per week for each \$1,000 of income you receive annually. (So if you make \$20,000 a year, you would give \$20 a week or \$1,040 a year.) What's important is not that we all give the same, but that we all act as stewards of what God has so lovingly given us.

Included with this letter are a 2013 pledge card and a survey of "The Gifts We Bring: Time, Talent, and Treasure." We are inviting you to bring your pledge card and survey to worship on October 14 for a special service of dedication and blessing. Our prayers for you are filled with gratitude. Thank you. 
