A paraplegic since an auto accident at age nineteen, Hockenberry is the author of a best-selling memoir, *Moving Violations: War Zones, Wheelchairs and Declarations of Independence*. Mr. Hockenberry is currently co-host of the live public radio morning news program, *The Takeaway*, produced by Public Radio International and WNYC New York.
